**2. VERNON HILLS SUMMER CELEBRATION, 1001 LAKEVIEW PKWY, REQUESTS A CLASS “G” LIQUOR LICENSE**

Village Manager Kalmar representing the Vernon Hills Summer Celebration Committee presented before the Liquor & License Commission to request a Class “G” liquor license for 2018 Summer Celebration. The event will take place from Wednesday, July 18 through Sunday, July 22 at 1001 Lakeview Parkway (Century Park) in Vernon Hills. Only BASSET trained volunteers are permitted to sell and serve beer and wine. The Village also requested waiving the \$100 fee.

Motion by Deputy Commissioner Hebda, second by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt to approve a Class “G” liquor license and waiver of \$100 fee for Vernon Hills 2018 Summer Celebration from July 18 through July 22 at 1001 Lakeview Parkway (Century Park) in Vernon Hills. The event will take place on Saturday, September 29 at the Metra Station parking lot, 75 Route 45 in Vernon Hills. Only BASSET trained volunteers are permitted to sell and serve beer and wine. The Village also requested waiving the \$100 fee.

Motion by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt, second by Deputy Commissioner Hebda, to approve a Class "G" liquor license and waiver of \$100 fee for Vernon Hills 2018 Oktoberfest. The event will take place on September 29 at the Metra parking lot, 75 Route 45 in Vernon Hills. Only BASSET trained volunteers are permitted to sell and serve beer and wine.


Motion by Deputy Commissioner Hebda, second by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt, to adjourn the Liquor and License Commission Hearing.
