ORDINANCE NUMBER 2010-017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, CHAPTER 25, SECTION 25-23 COMPREHENSIVE FEES AND PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, in order to promote the public health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the people of Vernon Hills, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills is authorized to prescribe rules, regulations, and standards for the construction and use of public property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of the Whole on January 19, 2010 concurred with staff recommendation to increase the daily parking fee to offset operating costs and fees to for the Station and Parking Lot; and

WHEREAS, METRA, has concurred with increasing the daily fee from \$1.50 to \$1.75; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of the fee increase will be March 1, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 25, Section 25-23 of the Village of Vernon Hills Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and is approved to read as follows:

Sec. 25-23. Traffic and Motor Vehicles - Chapter 22

Section 25-23 Traffic and Motor Vehicles –Chapter 22	
Commuter Parking Fees	
Daily Fee	\$1.75
Long-Term (per day, maximum of 10 paid days)	\$1.75
Bi-Monthly Fee	\$55.00

SECTION II. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. Repeal and Savings Clause. All resolutions, policies or ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION V. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and in effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 2010-017.




