ORDINANCE NO. 2010-053

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, CHAPTER 19, SECTION 19-4, POLITICAL SIGNS

WHEREAS, The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills is authorized to prescribe minimum standards for the purpose of promoting the convenience and general welfare for the people of Vernon Hills including the appropriate display of political signs; and

WHEREAS, The Villages Sign Code provides regulations that permit the display of political campaign signs no longer than thirty days prior to the election and requires their removal within seven days following an election; and

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois passed a new law that would allow the display of political signs on residential property during any period with said law further restricting municipalities from preempting this allowance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees having reviewed the new State of Illinois law and local regulations at its COW meeting on September 8, 2010 have determined that an amendment to the Vernon Hills Sign Code is appropriate to comply with state requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 19, Section 19-4(5)(a), "Political and Public Issue Signs" be amended by deleting this section in its entirety and replacing with the following language to read as follows:

Section 19-4(5)(a): "Political and public issue signs shall not be displayed longer than 30 calendar days prior to an election and shall be removed within 7 days following an election, except that such signs located on residential property may be displayed during any period of time"

SECTION XI. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION XII. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION XIII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 2011.


SECTION XIV. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2010-053


