

RESOLUTION 2016-096

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2015-055 AND AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN PAYMENT TO BALANCED ENVIRONMENTS, INC. FOR SPECIALIZED LAWN MOWING & LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE OF VILLAGE PROPERTY AND PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE 2015-16 SEASON FROM \$70,000 TO \$71,192.11

WHEREAS, the Village Board approved Resolution 2015-055 authorizing the Vernon Hills Public Works Department to extend the specialized mowing and landscape maintenance of Village Property contract with Balanced Environments, Inc. for the 2015-16 Season for an amount not to exceed \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, work performed under the contract included mowing of the Fairway Dr. and Sullivan Rd. public ROW's; pruning on the Butterfield Rd. island and at the Golf Course, as well as additional fall clean-up at the Police Station Communication Center and the Village Hall; and

WHEREAS, some additional work was added mid-season to plant 500 perennials on the Butterfield median and to perform plant bed work for a combined cost of \$8,445; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the first April 2016 specialized mowing totaled \$7,559.70; therefore, bringing the total cost for landscape maintenance for the 2015-16 season to \$71,192.11; and exceeding the not to exceed amount of \$70,000 by \$1,192.11; and

WHEREAS, staff is seeking approval to amend Resolution 2015-055 and increase payment to Balanced Environments, Inc. for specialized landscape maintenance of Village property for the 2015-16 season from \$70,000 to \$71,192.11.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Finance Director is authorized to increase payments to Balanced Environments, Inc. from \$70,000 to \$71,192.11 for specialized lawn and landscape maintenance of Village property and public ROW's with Balanced Environments, Inc. for the 2015-16 season; and

THAT, the Finance Director is authorized to increase FY2015-16 purchase order #575 to Balanced Environments, Inc. from \$70,000 to \$71,192.11.
