

RESOLUTION 2016-103

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGES OF VERNON HILLS AND GRAYSLAKE FOR ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have mutual desires to facilitate electronic recycling efforts in Lake County;

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) supports electronic recycling services in Lake County;

WHEREAS, Grayslake is an electronic recycling location that supports SWALCO members and Lake County residents;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10, of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, (1998), authorize and encourage intergovernmental cooperation, and this Agreement is entered into pursuant to the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation provisions of said Constitution and Act.

WHEREAS, Grayslake shall provide the necessary location, labor, equipment and materials for the purpose of electronic recycling within the Village of Grayslake.

WHEREAS, Vernon Hills shall provide two Public Works staff members once a month to assist at Grayslake's recycling center or at a level agreeable to both parties.

WHEREAS, the term of this Agreement shall commence on June 21, 2016 and terminate on December 31, 2017 (the "Initial Term"). This Agreement shall automatically renew for additional one (1) year terms (the "Renewal Terms") unless either party provides written notice of its intention not to renew.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Village President is authorized to sign the attached Intergovernmental Agreement for Electronic Recycling, subject to review, revision, and approval by the Village Attorney.
