**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE
MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEMBERS OF
THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS**

WHEREAS, Section 2-32 of the Village Code sets forth that the Board of Trustees members shall receive compensation for services as shall be provided by the Mayor and Board of Trustees from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-53 of the Village Code sets forth that the Mayor shall receive compensation for services as shall be provided by the Mayor and Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-4 of the Village Code designates the Mayor as the local liquor control commissioner of the Village and charges the Mayor with the administration of the applicable provisions of the Illinois Liquor Control Act and the provisions of Chapter 3 of the Village Code relating to alcoholic liquor control and food preparation and service that may be enacted from time to time by the Village; and

WHEREAS, no increases in compensation for the Mayor or Board of Trustees members have been authorized for a period of over approximately twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is reasonable and appropriate to increase the compensation commensurate with the duties performed by the Mayor and Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 3.1-50-5 salaries and other compensation shall not be increased or decreased during the term of any elected municipal officer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 3.1-50-10 the salaries that are fixed by ordinance for those officers who hold elective office for a definite term shall neither be increased nor diminished during that term and shall be fixed at least 180 days before the beginning of the terms of the officers whose compensation is to be fixed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Village's home rule authority, it is the intent of the Corporate Authorities that the date at which time the increases will take effect for the Mayor will be the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Corporate Authorities in May of 2013 (now anticipated to be May 7, 2013); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Village's home rule authority, it is the intent of the Corporate Authorities that the date at which time the increases will take effect for the Board of Trustees members shall be upon the commencement of their new term of office, which shall be at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village in May of 2013, or in May of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees find it reasonable and appropriate to amend Section 2-32 and Section 2-53 of the Village Code to codify the increases contemplated in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE may it be hereby ordained as follows:

SECTION 1: From and after the commencement of the new term of office for mayor, which term commences at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village

of Vernon Hills in May of 2013 (now anticipated to be May 7, 2013), the compensation for the Mayor shall be increased to a total amount of fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) per year.

SECTION 2: From and after the commencement of the new term of office for those Board of Trustees members elected in 2009, which term commences at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills in May of 2013 (now anticipated to be May 7, 2013), the compensation shall be increased to a total amount of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) per year.

SECTION 3: From and after the commencement of the new term of office for those Board of Trustees members elected in 2011, which term commences at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills in May of 2015 (now anticipated to be May 5, 2015), the compensation increased to a total amount of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) per year.

SECTION 4: The Corporate Authorities acknowledge that the Mayor's compensation for performing the duties of the local liquor control commissioner of the Village is currently one thousand (\$1,000) dollars and said compensation shall remain the same and not be increased by this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect as of the date passed by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills.




