**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO
BE SURPLUS AND PROVIDING FOR
THE SALE BY PUBLIC OR INTERNET
AUCTION**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to sell such surplus property by public or internet auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely.

1. One (1) battery powered 12" amber LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet.
2. One (1) battery powered 12" red LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet.
3. One (1) battery powered 12" amber LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet.
4. One (1) Echo PE2400 gas powered edger, serial number 052920.
5. One Milwaukee #6205 electric chainsaw, serial number 0004781757.
6. One (1) Stihl MS200T gas powered chainsaw, serial number 165623114.
7. One (1) Stihl 038 gas powered chainsaw, serial number 328076399.
8. One (1) Stihl 011AV gas powered chainsaw, serial number 21802C253.
9. One (1) Stihl 009L gas powered chainsaw, serial number 218515844.

SECTION II. The said surplus property is to be sold through a public or internet auction.

SECTION III. The said surplus property shall individually be withdrawn from the sale at the public or internet auction unless the following minimum sum shall be bid for said property:

1. One (1) battery powered 12" amber LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$50.00.
2. One (1) battery powered 12" red LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet described in Section I (2) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$50.00.
3. One (1) battery powered 12" amber LED flashing beacon with solar panel and battery cabinet described in Section I (3) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$50.00.
4. One (1) Echo PE2400 gas powered edger, serial number 052920 described in Section I (4) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$20.00.
5. One Milwaukee #6205 electric chainsaw, serial number 0004781757 described in Section I (5) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$25.00.
6. One (1) Stihl MS200T gas powered chainsaw, serial number 165623114 described in Section I (6) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$25.00.
7. One (1) Stihl 038 gas powered chainsaw, serial number 328076399 described in Section I (7) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$10.00.
8. One (1) Stihl 011AV gas powered chainsaw, serial number 21802C253 described in Section I (8) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$10.00.
9. One (1) Stihl 009L gas powered chainsaw, serial number 218515844 described in Section I (9) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$10.00.
10. One (1) Stihl 019T gas powered chainsaw, serial number 238976412 described in Section I (10) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$10.00.
11. One (1) Echo 280 EP gas powered chainsaw, serial number 377147 described in Section I (11) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$10.00.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2012-025.




