**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO
BE SURPLUS AND PROVIDING FOR
THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION
THROUGH THE INTERNET**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to sell such surplus property by public auction through the internet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely:

1. 2002 Jeep 4 Grand Cherokee Wheel Drive VIN/1J4GW58SX2C111733
2. 2003 Ford Crown Vic VIN2FAFP71WX3X201028

SECTION II. The said surplus vehicle shall individually be withdrawn from the sale at the public auction through the internet unless the following minimum sum shall be bid for said vehicle:

1. 2002 Jeep Grand Cherokee 4 Wheel Drive described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1,500.
2. 2003 Ford Crown Vic described in Section I (2) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1,500.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VI. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2011-046.




