

ORDINANCE 2011-051

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN
VILLAGE EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS AND
HAVING LITTLE OR NO VALUE TO DONATE
TO THE VERNON HILLS PARK DISTRICT

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exists certain surplus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of such surplus equipment by donating it to the Vernon Hills Park District:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I. The following equipment has little or no value and declared to be surplus namely:

4 each Plan Hold@ 5 Drawer Flat File Cabinets

SECTION II. The said surplus equipment with a value of less than \$10.00 is no longer needed and may be donated to the Vernon Hills Park District

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


SECTION VI. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2011-051
