**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF
VERNON HILLS CODE OF ORDINANCES
CHAPTER 3, LIQUOR LICENSE CODE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Village, as a municipal corporation, has a duty to regulate the purchase, sale and serving of alcoholic beverages to the public for the protection of the public, health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt this ordinance amending the Liquor Control Ordinance of the Village of Vernon Hills pursuant to its duty to regulate the purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages within the Village of Vernon Hills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 3, section 3-26(f), "Prohibited Conduct" of the Vernon Hills Alcoholic Liquor Control Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3-26 (f) Prohibited Conduct: No person shall consume or be in possession of any alcoholic liquor on licensed premises other than that alcoholic liquor sold and dispensed by the licensee. The licensee or his/her agent shall have the authority to order the immediate removal of any alcoholic liquor carried onto licensed premises in violation of this section.

Exemption: Assisted and/or senior living facilities holding a current Vernon Hills Liquor License shall be exempt from this prohibition. This exemption applies to residents and their guests or visitors for consumption in the dining room."

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION III. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION V. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet for in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VI. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2014-011.




