

RESOLUTION 2016-153

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2016-076 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$45,000 TO ADVANCED BUSINESS NETWORKS FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT FOR FY 2016-17

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*"the Village"*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village uses Advanced Business Networks for its Information Technology support; and

WHEREAS, Advanced Business Networks offers blocks of over three hundred hours of Information Technology support at a 20% discount; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2016, the Village Board authorized the purchase of three hundred and seventy-five hours of support time estimated to cost \$45,000 for Village-wide information technology support not related to the Village's Dispatch Center per Resolution 2016-076; and

WHEREAS, based on usage, an additional block of hours will be needed to support the Village through the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board is required to approve all purchases over \$20,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT: The Finance Department is hereby authorized to make an additional payment to Advanced Business Networks up to \$45,000 for information technology support for FY 2016-17; and

SECTION 2: RELEASE OF PAYMENT: That the Finance Department is authorized to immediately release the payment for Advanced Business Networks prior to appearing on the invoice approval list.




