





**ORDINANCE 2017-006**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN  
VILLAGE PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND TO  
DISPOSE OF IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills ("*Village*") Police Department has been granted bitcoin property through the Federal Equitable Sharing Program; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that this bitcoin is surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of this surplus property.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION I.** The Village has identified that the bitcoin received is to be declared to be surplus; and

**SECTION II.** The said surplus property is to be disposed of in an appropriate manner.

**SECTION III.** The said surplus property is not usable in the continued operations of the Village of Vernon Hills Police Department.

**SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY** In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

**SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER.** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2017-006.




